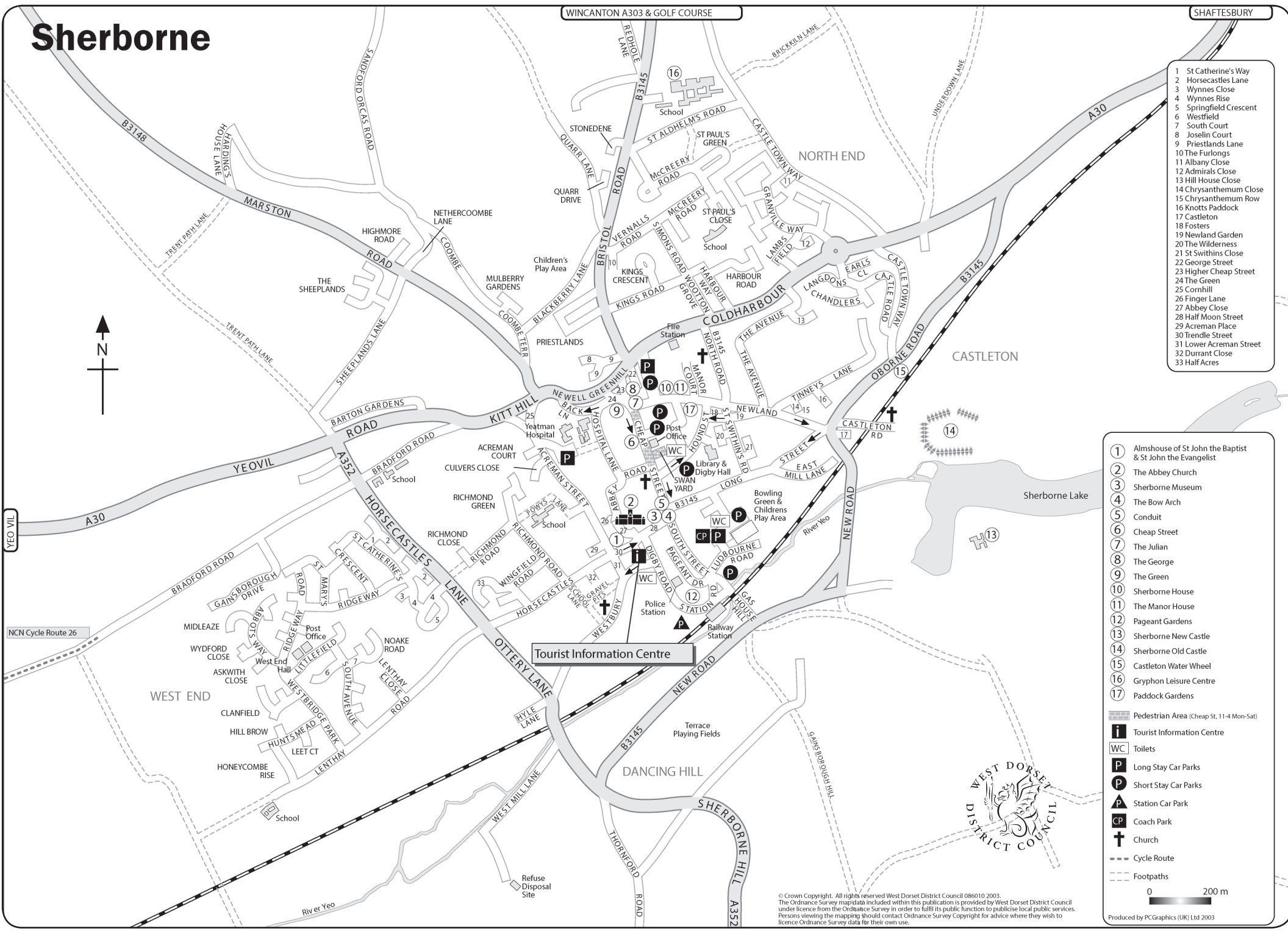

Parking in Sherborne

Sherborne is served by three Long Stay car parks and six shoppers' car parks. All car parks are operated on a Pay and Display basis.

Pay and Display tickets are not transferable between car parks. You are advised to read the charges board in each car park you visit as these vary depending on whether the car park is designated Short Stay or Long Stay. Tickets purchased after 6pm are valid from 8am the following day.

Season Tickets: These are available from the Council Offices in Dorchester either on a quarterly or yearly basis, to enable the regular user to park cheaper in our Long Stay car parks throughout the West Dorset area.

Disabled Badge Holders: Please refer to the disabled parking notices on display in each car park. Parking permits are available from the TIC for those in receipt of the Higher Rate of Mobility Allowance or equivalent. The permits entitle holders to 3 hours free parking per day.

Larger Vehicles: Lorries, coaches, motorhomes, caravans, caravanettes, trailers etc, can be accommodated at the Culverhayes car park in the commercial area. Regular users may benefit from commercial season tickets, available from parking services.
